Requirements

Students must know the notes on their instrument, be able to read music and want to improvise. Students must attend all classes and are required to perform in the student recital, except in the case of sickness, family or national emergencies.

Beginning Section

is for students who have little or no experience in improvising or playing jazz. This course will focus on developing basic improvisation and small group performance skills.

Intermediate/Advanced sections are for students who have past experience improvising in a school group or the AJW beginning class. This class will focus on soloing over more advanced song forms, chord changes and rhythmic feels. Audition required for these sections.

Sign Up Procedures

Contact John Damberg to reserve space and set up placement audition for new students. Students will perform one prepared piece of music and play major and blues scales. (907) 332-3234
