Course Content: This course will focus on developing song repertoire in a wide variety of styles including: Jazz, Blues, Latin, Funk, etc. Students will build song repertoire through reading music, rehearsing as a band, and listening & transcribing songs. They will have hands on experience exploring music improvisation and expressing their inner vocabulary on their instruments. Weekly assignments will be given to promote learning new vocabulary, song repertoire, and developing improvisation skills.

Requirements:

1. For students who have past experience improvising music using the blues form and scales in either a previous AJW class or a Middle/High School Jazz Ensemble. They must know the notes on their instrument, how to read music, and demonstrate basic music theory skills including: blues, major and pentatonic scales, be able to read and form basic triads and 7th chords including major, minor, augmented, half diminished, and diminished 7th chords.
2. Students need to attend all sessions except in cases of sickness or family emergency. There will be no refunds for missed classes. Please notify your instructor at least 24 hours in advance when you will be absent.
3. Students agree to come to class prepared learn and to work to fulfill the class requirements, practice assigned music, and do weekly homework assignments. They need to bring their music, notebook, pencil, and instrument
